# ***HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT SYSTEM***

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- **30 Credits to Graduate in Manitoba**
  - **Of those 30, 17 are required courses**
  - **Of those 30, 13 are optional**

# TIMETABLE

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- 40 blocks of time (over 4 years of high school), but students only need 30 credits (1 credit per course)
- Grade 9- Math and English Language Arts run all year long (therefore, only 8 credits earned in grade 9)
- In Grade 10, students normally take 5 credits/ courses per semester (no spares)
- In Grade 11 and 12, spares become an option

# COURSE OPTIONS

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- **Grade 9**

- English Language Arts- runs all year
- Grade 9 Math- runs all year
- Grade 9 Physical Education
- Grade 9 Science
- Grade 9 Social Studies
- Options: 3 credits remaining for elective courses (electives listed later)

- **Grade 10**

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- English Language Arts
- Grade 10 Math
  - OPTIONS ARE:
    - ESSENTIALS MATH
    - INTRO TO APPLIED/ PRE-CAL
- Grade 10 Physical Education
- Grade 10 Geography
- Grade 10 Science
- Options: 3-5 credits remaining for elective courses (electives listed later)

## Grade 11/12

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- Compulsory courses:
  - Math
    - Options include Essentials, Applied, Pre-cal (depending on interest and staffing)
  - ELA
    - Comprehensive, Transactional, Literary (depending on interest and staffing)
  - Phys. Ed
  - Grade 11 History- no mandatory History course in grade 12 year
  - Options for up to 6 elective credits

## OPTIONS FOR ELECTIVES

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- Possible optional courses: Band, Woods, Art, French, Home Economics, Hockey, Outdoor Education, Photography, other courses according to interest
- Outside of regular schedule: Drama, Jazz Band, Community Service credit
- Later in high school:
  - Apprenticeship program
  - Credit for Employment (2 credits max, need lifeworks course)
  - Peer Assistance credit
- Independent options (Distance Ed and Informnet courses.)
  - \* not highly recommended due to low student completion rate.
  - does come with a cost
- Private music option and Cadet credit
