

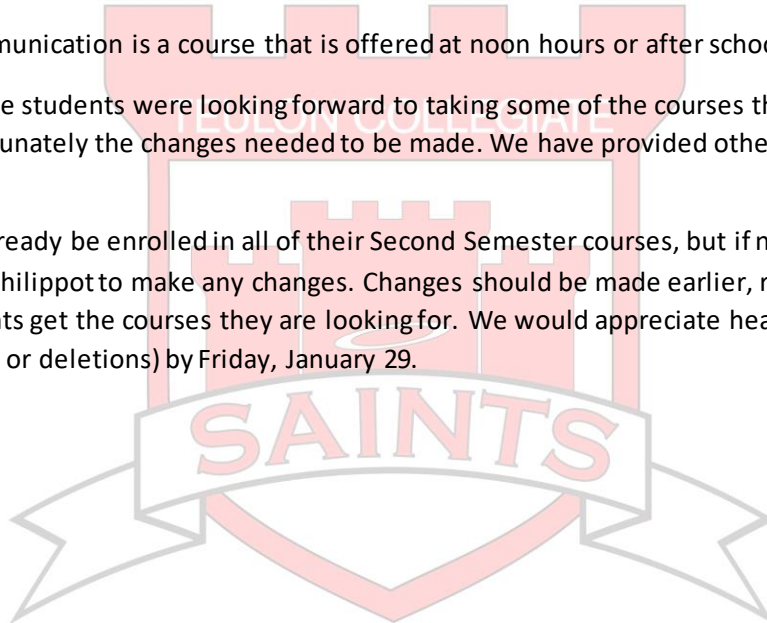
SECOND SEMESTER COURSE CHANGES and COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Due to factors related to COVID and staffing we have had to make the following course changes for Second Semester:

- No Grade 9 or Grade 10 French (will be offered in 2021-2022)
- Woodworking class now only being offered to Grade 10s. No Woodworking being offered to 11s and 12s Second Semester (was offered in Semester One).
- Life Works 20S only available for Grade 9 and 10 classes
- Computer Course offered for Grade 11s and Grade 12s will be Information & Communication Technology (Data Collection-Analysis & Web Design)
- Industrial Arts Course offered to Grade 11s and 12s will be Graphic Communication Technology
- Applying Information and Communication Technology (AIT) is being offered to the Grade 9s and Grade 10s
- Print Communication is a course that is offered at noon hours or after school

We know that some students were looking forward to taking some of the courses that we have had to change, but unfortunately the changes needed to be made. We have provided other opportunities in their place.

Students should already be enrolled in all of their Second Semester courses, but if not, they should contact Madame Philippot to make any changes. Changes should be made earlier, rather than later, to ensure that students get the courses they are looking for. Applying Information and Communication Technology

This year we will use office productivity software to create documents, spreadsheets, databases, web pages and presentations. We will explore multimedia production to create graphics, animation, audio and video. The internet and email will be used to communicate and to help gather data and research. Finally, we will look at acceptable use and ethical differences of technology at home and our workplaces.

Print Communications

Students learn the skills necessary to plan and produce the text portion of print and electronic documents, appropriate for the school yearbook. This course is offered at noon hours or after school.

Life Works

The Life Works curriculum is designed to connect school learning with workplace and labour market realities. The course will focus on Personal Management, Career Exploration, Learning and Planning, Job Seeking/Job Maintenance and Career and Community Experiences.

Graphic Communication Technology

This course will consist of concepts pertaining to Drafting, and Graphic Design. Some of the processes it will cover are vinyl cutting, perspective drawing, technical drawing, photo and image manipulation, and 3D printing. Some programs that we will be covering are, various AutoCAD programs, Photoshop Elements, 3D and vinyl cutting software.

Information & Communication Technology (Data Collection-Analysis & Web Design)

This course provides students with skills & knowledge to collect, organize, manipulate and analyze data by solving problems using spreadsheets. In addition, students will learn about, design, develop and publish a simple website. We will also learn how to properly type.
